Dear Dr Yifat,

I have examined Mr. Niv Sarig which is your patient.

Cardiac a-symptomatic. In his background born with a VSD and passed 2 heart surgeries with a successful closure. Known heart arrhythmia disorders and a disturbance with the electrical conductance without any clinical symptom. Able to endure substantial physical stress and with accordance to his chronological age maintain sport activities.

In the cardiac examination: Blood pressure 130/70 lying down, standing up 56 heart bits per minute regularly, clean lungs, heart sound regular, Systolic murmur emission 1-2/6 non radiating basically. Soft abdominal without organomegaly. Limbs without edema. Peripheral pulses was not felt two sided radials (scars at the area, probably was used for artery monitoring at the operations).

ECG – RBBB LAHB and PR=0.2

Holter-ECG: Superior ventricular arrhythmia – APBS in bundles and discrete VPBS. No change was found respectively with previous Holter checks.

Stress Eco-Cardiogram: Regular, without signs of inter-ventricular emission. Good physical shape.

Summary: No new findings concerning past tests, also ECG electrical arrhythmia disorder is without a change in diagrams of previous years.

No objection for continuing physical activities fitted to his age.
Recommend an annual cardiac monitoring.
